

The students enrolled in classes here at DMB DRIVER'S ED agree to read and adhere to the following rules and expectations.

Student must have obtained permission from parents or guardian to attend classes.

All students must have proof of being at least 15 years old.

SCHOOL EXPECTATIONS:

Classroom conduct should resemble the expectation of the public schools (middle schools, high schools and or universities) they attend.

Shoes, shirts and modest attire will be expected to ensure safety and reduce distraction during all lessons. Safety will be prioritized at all times.

Food may be allowed at teacher's discretion in which case students are responsible for cleaning up after themselves.

Appreciation and care will be required when using any classroom materials and in the case of abuse replacement will be demanded.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

Students must familiarize themselves with scheduled class days and times and are expected to be on time.

The course will require not less than 30 hours of classroom learning and 7 hours of behind the wheel instruction as required by the Graduated Licensing Program.

Students are responsible for attending all scheduled classes and making arrangements for making up work or time for missed days.

DISCIPLINE:

Students can expect to have parents called for repeated disturbances and when necessary parents will be required to remove disruptive students.

Students who are disruptive or have behavior issues will be first verbally warned, followed by a phone call to parents, and finally

rescheduled to attend a latter class or driving session which might prove more suitable. All students can expect to be treated with respect as well as treat others with respect.

CERTIFICATES:

Full participation will be required. Students should arrive with an attitude conducive to learning, note taking and taking part in discussion will be obligatory in order to receive certification for the class.

Students are responsible for getting make up work from the teacher.

Students who have not completed all of the requirements for the course will under no circumstance receive certification.

After passing the driving course final exam and road test students will receive certification of completion recognized by MVD.

FEES:

Missed drive times or testing will result in a \$30 rescheduling fee
Returned checks due to insufficient funds will require a \$30 reprocessing fee

Additional drives beyond the course requirements can be purchased at \$30/hr. Enrollment cancellation will need to be made by the **second** day of class for full reimbursement otherwise arrangements will be allowed for continuation at a later date.
